Anadia é um dos concelhos portugueses que possui uma maior ligação ao mundo das duas rodas. Prova disso é a existência do Centro de Alto Rendimento de Anadia – Velódromo Nacional, em Sangalhos, que é, na Europa, o único Centro Satélite do Centro Mundial de Ciclismo da União Ciclista Internacional. Este complexo desportivo moderno, inaugurado em 2009, foi criado para formar atletas, nacionais e internacionais, em regime de alto rendimento.

Nos últimos anos, têm vindo a ser criadas condições para sessões de treino e estágios, com o apoio de treinadores especializados da Federação Portuguesa de Ciclismo e ainda do departamento médico.

A territory with cycling at its genesis

Anadia is one of the Portuguese municipalities with a stronger connection to the two-wheeled world. Proof of that is the existence of the Anadia High Performance Centre – National Velodrome, in Sangalhos, which is, in Europe, the only Satellite Centre of the World Cycling Centre of the Union Cycliste Internationale. This modern sports complex, inaugurated in 2009, was created to train national and international athletes in a high performance regime.

In recent years, conditions have been created for training sessions and training camps, with the support of specialized coaches from the Portuguese Cycling Federation and also the medical department.





A realização em Portugal dos Campeonatos da Europa de Ciclismo, para os escalões de juniores e Sub-23, ao longo de três semanas, tem um significado muito expressivo quanto à atração que as organizações desportivas internacionais têm pelas condições únicas que Portugal é capaz de oferecer e, simultaneamente, atesta a capacidade e competência exibidas pela Federação Portuguesa de Ciclismo na resposta a este tipo de desafios.

Igualmente significativo é o facto desta competição com sede organizativa em Portugal dizer respeito não a uma, mas a três disciplinas distintas do Ciclismo: o BTT, a estrada e a pista. À escolha de Portugal para esta organização também não é certamente alheia a qualidade dos resultados desportivos alcançados pelos ciclistas portugueses nos últimos anos, que os levou ao pódio em diversas competições internacionais e, simbolicamente, à estreia em Ciclismo de pista nos Jogos Olímpicos Tóquio 2020.

Neste quadro, resta-me, pois, desejar que os Campeonatos da Europa em Anadia possam ser mais uma grande manifestação desportiva organizada em Portugal, com resultados de excelência em todas as vertentes.

Holding the European Cycling Championships in Portugal for the junior and under-23 age groups over three weeks has a very significant significance in terms of the attraction that international sports organisations have for the unique conditions Portugal is able to offer and, at the same time, attests to the ability and competence displayed by the Portuguese Cycling Federation in responding to this type of challenge.

Equally significant is the fact that this competition, organized in Portugal, concerns not one, but three distinct Cycling disciplines: MTB, road and track. This transversality also reflects what has been the evolution of the sport in our country, propitiated by the implementation of an infrastructure such as the Anadia track, the town which hosts the organization. Portugal's choice for this organization is certainly not unrelated to the quality of the sporting results achieved by Portuguese cyclists in recent years, which led them to the podium in various international competitions and, symbolically, to the debut in track cycling in the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games.

In this context, I can only hope that the European Championships in Anadia may be another great sport event organised in Portugal, with excellent results in all areas.

Entre 30 de junho e 19 de julho, o concelho de Anadia, com a sua rica história e cultura, será a indiscutível capital europeia do ciclismo, acolhendo um evento único. The territorial promotion will also be a reality, since dozens of national teams will be able to experience everything Anadia and the region have to offer to those who practice cycling.

The Portuguese Cycling Federation is thankful for the UEC's trust in the organisation of these European Championships, as well as for the support of the Government, Anadia City Hall and all partners.

TIME TRIAL - START AND FINISH MAP




